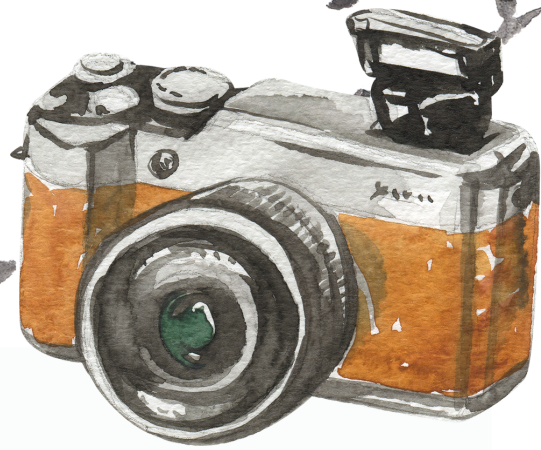

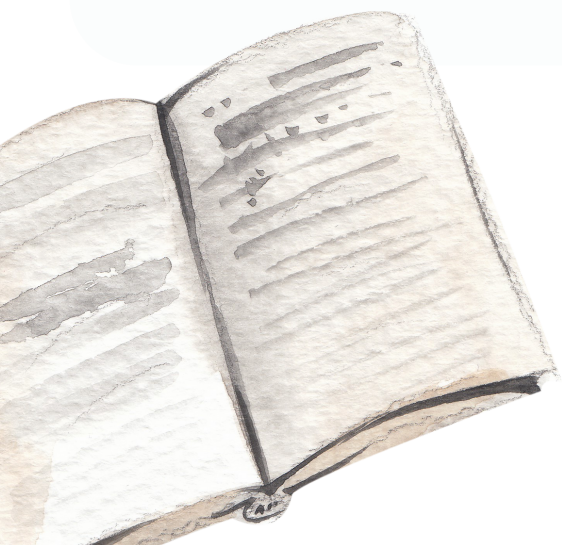

- Draw your favourite building, statue or view

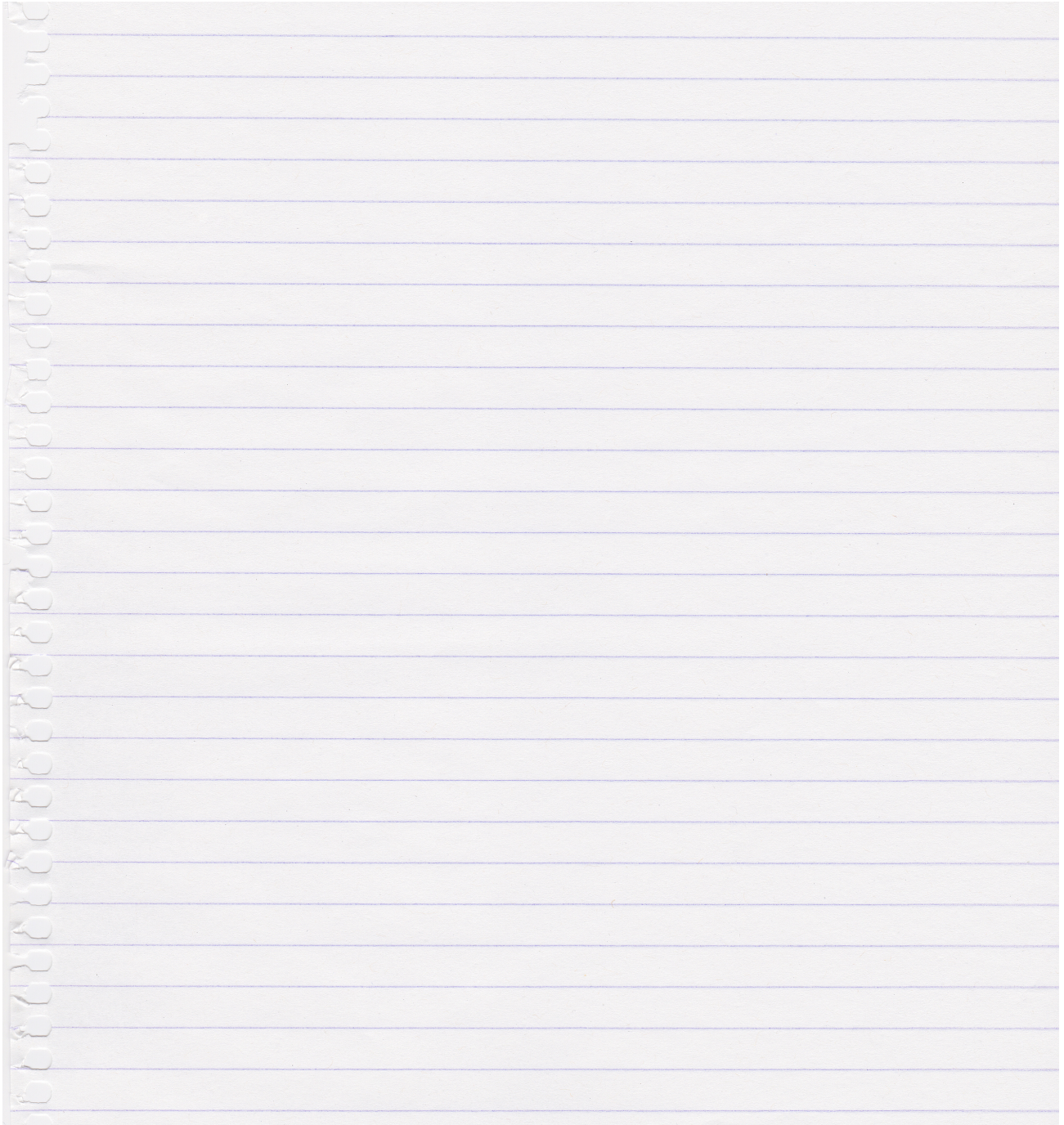
